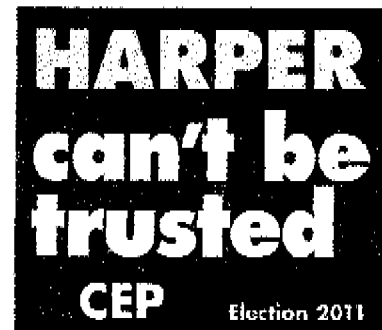
There will be two town hall meetings by phone.
